

The Primary Section – Conditions and Workshops (2 pages)

Designer Prize : \$100 (Goes to highest scoring entrant)

Model Prize : \$50 (Goes to the model of highest scoring design)

Primary (any child to Year 6 inclusive)

Entry Close Date : 5pm Saturday March 30th (two weeks before the event)

Theme : Headpieces and Hats.

This is a chance from Primary School children to be involved in our Wearable Art competition and we want to see what amazing hat designs and decorations you can produce.

For this round hats and headpieces can be anything you wear on your head – a traditionally shaped hat, a knitted beanie you've made or any support that holds a structure. We have a couple of simple rules :

1. You must make your own hat (can be out of anything you wish) During judging you may be asked how you constructed your hat just so we know you did it mostly yourself – its ok to get help and advice but you must do your own construction.
2. You must decorate your own hat – this can be with whatever and however your heart desires.
3. You must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian on the day of the event – this person must stay with you for the duration of your section (except for when you are wowing the crowd on the runway!)

Judging Criteria for this section :

3 criteria for this section.

A maximum of ten points for each criteria. Score will be out of 30.

1. Creativity – the more creative the better your score.
2. Materials Used – unconventional and unexpected is the way to go!.
3. Overall appeal – How it all comes together.

We encourage designers to wear their own creations in this section – although you may source a model if you prefer. Choose wardrobe that either compliments your hat or helps it stand out but you won't be judged on your outfit just your creation.

We expect quite a few entries for this section and recommend that you arrive in your chosen outfit. A very small number of change rooms are available but to avoid congestion we suggest arriving prepared.
